Press-conference of the Secretary of American Communist Party

Secretary of American communist party, Gus Hall kept a press-conference at the direction of Italian Communist Party in Rome.

Gus Hall came to Italy with Arnold Johnson, member of the direction of American Communist Party, after having been in S.S.R.U. and socialist countries. Gian Carlo Pajetta, member of the political bureau of Italian Communist party, opened the press-conference. He outlined that Gus Hall was sentenced according to Mc Party's legislation for twelve years.
