IN THE INTERESTS OF PEACE

Washington, the capital of the United States of America. State figures of the United States, representatives of the Soviet side, over a thousand representatives of the press gathered at the White House on the 18th of June to greet Leonid Brezhnev, General Secretary of the CPSU Central Committee. President Nixon and Mrs. Nixon warmly greeted Leonid Brezhnev. A Guard of Honour for the high guest. The people of Washington gave a warm welcome to Leonid Brezhnev. In his speech of greeting President Nixon emphasized the great importance of the summit Soviet-American talks that took place last year in Moscow for the deep changes in relations between the two great states. In his reply L.I. Brezhnev said that he and the comrades who arrived with him were ready to work hard so that the coming talks would answer the hopes of peoples and would serve the interests of the peaceful future of all peoples. From the very first the talks between the General Secretary of the Central Committee of the CPSU and the US President were of a business-like and concrete character. They were held in a spirit of consolidation and the further development of the principles of documents that were signed in Moscow a year ago: "The Basic Principles of Relations Between the USSR and the USA". The constructive character of Soviet-American talks became at once evident to the whole world, which closely and with increasing attention followed the historic dialogue between the leaders and state figures of the two countries. Agreements on cooperation in the fields of agriculture, transport, exploration of the World ocean, and a general agreement about contacts, exchanges and cooperation were signed already on the next day, on June 19th. Of special importance is the Agreement About Prevention of Nuclear War, which signifies the basics of international security. The Communique, signed by Leonid Brezhnev and Richard Nixon, states that the summit talks greatly contribute towards the development of mutually advantageous relations between the Soviet Union and the United States. The Communique further stresses that these talks will favourably influence international relations.

HAY MOWING

Intensive hay mowing is being carried out at the Kirov Collective Farm of the Rostov District. In reply to the Decree of the CC of the CPSU and the Council of Ministers of the USSR "About Measures for the Timely Storage of Fodder and Readiness of State and Collective Farms for the Hibernation of Cattle in 1973-74" agricultural workers take active part in Socialist emulation. Mechanisers of the Kirov Collective Farm fulfill their daily tasks 140-150%. Fertilizer sprinklers follow the harvesting machines on the fields. Then the rain installations are switched on. Such methods allow to grow 3-4 harvests of hay a year. Here at the farm the hay is processed into granulated fodder. The collective farmers aim to store 1,5 norms of fodder for the cattle this year. The providing of fodder on an industrial basis will help to produce ample meat. Installations for growing chlorella were built at the Kuban Collective Farm "Kavkaz". Light, warm temperature, constant circulation of water saturated with carbonic acid gas make ideal conditions for speedy reproduction of chlorella cells. This type of water plants contain a large amount of albumen and vitamins. Addition of chlorella to the fodder stimulates the growth of cattle and gives an almost 30% increase of productivity.

OIL FIELDS IN THE CASPIAN SEA

The viaducts over the unique oil fields on the Caspian Sea have spread over more than 200 km. Roads and towns for workers were built on these viaducts. Aidin Abasagayev began working here as an assistant 23 years ago. At present he is the head of a brigade which was assigned to the most important sector of the explorations of oil - the boring of an experimental bore-hole five thousand meters deep. The bore had never gone so deep into the Caspian Sea. Workers of this oilfield participate in Socialist emulation under the motto: to give the country more production, of a better quality and at less cost.

CMEA - INTEGRATION IN ACTION

An international exhibition "A United System of Electronic Computers of Socialist Countries" was mounted in Moscow at the Exhibition of the Accomplishments of the People's Economy of the USSR. It demonstrated the accomplishments of mutual efforts of Bulgaria, Hungary, the GDR, Poland, USSR and Czechoslovakia in creating a united system of electronic computers. The construction of the machines is to a great extent unified, which allows to cooperate and specialise in conditions of their mass production. Now the main task is to put these United System Computers into use in the people's economy of Socialist countries. No doubt this task will be successfully accomplished.

HOLIDAY ON ICE

Performances of the famous American "Holiday on Ice" company are taking place at the Palace of Sports in Moscow. This is the fourth tour of the guests from the USA in our country. Their performances will also take place in Leningrad.
