The strengthening and widening of comparation between the two countries found its expression in the joint statement about the visit of L.I. headmey to the YMO. THE STANGE THE STAN CIL PIPE-LINE

The steep banks of the Yenisei River. The great river became an obstacle on the way of the bailders of the trans-siberian oil pipe-line anjero-Sudjansk-Krasnoyersh-Nakhodka. It was decided to cross the Yenisei by lowering 900 meters of the pipe-line to its bettom. The forcing of the crossing has begun. Bivers go under the water to lay the pipe-line into the dug-out trench. By the end of the tenth day the winch pulled out the steel pipes which weigh over 500 tens to the right bank of the river. The new pipe-line will allow the oil into Transcoversk by the end of the year.

The YAK-AO is a well-known model of a Soviet passenger plane. These comparitively small planes for internal air-routes have excellent flight qualities and are very reliable. The maidem flight of this plane was accomplished in autumn of 1960 on the line Mosson-Mostroma. Today the YAK-AO took on board its ten millionth passenger. At present the YAK-AO are making 250 flights a day in the Soviet Union and have already flown 250 million kms.
