

### THE KAMAZ STEEPLEJACKS

KAMAZ, the largest project of the 9th five-year plan has become a laboratory of methods of work, a school of skilled work. Communist Valeri Kuznetsov has been working 14 years as a fitter. ### A UNIQUE MILK PIPE-LINE

The "Jalpak" meadows are high in the Caucasus Mountains. The meadows are rich with grass and are the main grazing fields of Karachayevo-Cherkessia. Hundreds of thousands of cattle find ample food on these meadows til late Autumn. Cattle of the "Krasnogorsky" State Farm. Over 12 tons of milk are sold daily to the state by the brigade of Ramazan Adjiev. Tractors carry the milk to the reception center high in the mountains. From here, from an altitude of 3000 m. the milk is sent down by a special pipe-line. In seven minutes cisterns receive the milk on the plain. The mountain pipe-line allows to reduce the time for transportation, to cut down losses and to preserve the food qualities of milk.

### SPORTS

Motorcyclists of USSR, Poland, Czechoslovakia and the FRG competed on the Leningrad track for the right to participate in the final of the World Speedway Championships. From the very beginning acute fight for victory began between Polish and Soviet sportsmen. Soviet drivers are in white helmets. By number of points the teams of Poland and the USSR were ahead of the teams of Czechoslovakia and the FRG and won the right to fight for victory in the finals in Alchingen, FRG, with the teams of Britain and Sweden for the title of World Champions.
