November 15th, 1978SOVIET-VIETNAMESE TALKS

Soviet-Vietnamese talks were held in Kremlin in an atmosphere of fraternal friendship and complete unity of views. Participating in the talks from the Soviet side were: L.I. Brezhnev, General Secretary of the CPSU CC, President of the Presidium of the USSR Supreme Soviet, Members of the Politbureau of the CPSU CC - A.N. Kosygin, Chairman of the USSR Council of Ministers, M.A. Suslov, Secretary of the CPSU CC, A.A. Gromyko, Minister of Foreign Affairs of the USSR, D.F. Ustinov, Minister of Defence of the USSR, K.V. Rusakov, Secretary of the CPSU CC and other officials. From the Vietnamese side: Le Duan, General Secretary of the CPV, Phan Van Dong, Prime Minister of the Socialist Republic of Vietnam, and other Vietnamese officials. It was stated during the talks that the strengthening of friendship between the USSR and Vietnam answers the vital interests of Soviet and Vietnamese peoples.

Soviet-Vietnamese Documents were signed at the Grand Kremlin Palace in conclusion of the talks. A Treaty of Friendship and Cooperation between the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics and the Socialist Republic of Vietnam was signed by L.I. Brezhnev, General Secretary of the CPSU CC, President of the Presidium of the USSR Supreme Soviet, by A.N. Kosygin, Member of the Politbureau of the CPSU CC, Chairman of the USSR Council of Ministers, by Le Duan, General Secretary of the Communist Party of Vietnam Central Committee, and by Phan Van Dong, Prime Minister of the Socialist Republic of Vietnam. A number of economic Agreements were also signed. Party and state officials of USSR and Vietnam were present at the signing.

The Party and Government delegation of Vietnam was cordially greeted at the Ordjonikidze Engineering Plant in Moscow. A meeting of Soviet-Vietnamese friendship was held here. Grishin, Member of the Politbureau of the CPSU CC, First Secretary of the Moscow City Committee of the Party, and Rusakov, Secretary of the CPSU CC, other Soviet officials arrived at the plant together with Vietnamese guests.
